Submissions Process

EMS Reference encourages unsolicited photos received with the requirement that the photographer, videographer or illustrator submitting the materials owns the copyright to the files.

Submissions must include an introduction in the email and the following attachments:

- The electronic files in one of the following formats: jpg, jpeg, png, tif, tiff, ai and eps
- The phone number and email address of the photographer or illustrator.

File Preparation

EMS Reference seeks imagery that details the types of assessments and procedures providers perform on scene. We prefer well-framed images that have room around the frame edges to crop.

Photos: We prefer "action" shots, which show providers interacting with patients, performing tasks in the field, or using equipment. Please include captions that indicate response organizations pictured, city, state and type of incident. For headline images, we prefer horizontal images or images that can be cropped horizontally. Other images can be any shape or size.

Non-photo medial and operational imagery and illustrations: This includes ECG strips, run reports, protocols and other non-photo images. We require all patient identifiers are removed and are not identifiable. We require all medical illustrations be original and anatomically correct.

Videos: We do not have video capability at this time. Please email us and we'll be sure to let you know when we have video capability.
